pm days'07 – student paper award: Dates

- Abstract submission: **November 5th, 2006**
- Notification of acceptance: December 15th, 2006
- Full paper submission: February 1st, 2007
- Notification of winners: April 10th, 2007
- Participation pm days'07: May 10th – 11th, 2007

Two-stage application process

- The candidates submit the application form which includes an abstract.
- After notification of acceptance the full paper is submitted.

Criteria for Paper Evaluations

- Master and PhD students (max. 6 months after graduation)
- Papers must solely be written by one/more students
- Max. 15 pages/A4 in English language

- The paper must not have been published in scientific journals or at research conferences before
- Originality and innovation of content
- Current contribution concerning the further development of project management
- Research Paper with practical relevance
